**Kiosk setup**

Upon your arrival, please go to Confederation Park in front of City Hall of Ottawa, **across** from 110 Laurier Street. To meet us, please take a right at Elgin St, and after the 2 streets lights, take the **entrance** of the National Art Center and make it to the East side of the Park. You will see the 2 bigs tents and you will find us there.

Cars and trucks will have access to the site for delivery.

**Hours and dates**

- Saturday 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Sunday 11 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Monday 11 a.m. to 5 p.m.

You will have access to the site to set up your exhibit kiosk on Friday, July 29, from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. as well as Saturday, July 30, from 7 to 9 a.m.

**The kiosk setup must be completed for the opening of the fair, set for 10 a.m. on Saturday, July 30.**

Vehicles are only authorized on the site during the kiosk setup time. Note that vehicles are not allowed to circulate during fair hours and that the exhibitor agrees to respect the kiosk setup and takedown times. First you must register at the office on-site. We will give you badges that identify you as an exhibitor. All you have to do is insert

your business card.

You will then be able to return with your vehicle to unload your materials at the tent where you will be exhibiting. Once this is complete you can park your vehicles in the parking lot.

Parking for cars is free at the world exchange Plaza, at the corner of Metcalfe and Albert st., one block west of Confederation Park. I will get back to you soon for trucks parking.



Kiosks will be equipped with 1 table (8 feet by 32 inches), 2 chairs and electrical outlets. Exhibitors must bring their own extensions and wiring. No curtains. Exhibitors are responsible for decorating their kiosks.

Take down of kiosk can be Monday at 5 p.m. or Tuesday morning till 10 a.m.

There are no high-speed Internet connections on the site.

Volunteers will be available on-site to help you and answer your questions.

## **Meals on site**

Exhibitors will be able to buy healthy meals at the fair's food concessions. A dining area with picnic tables will be available for visitors and exhibitors.
